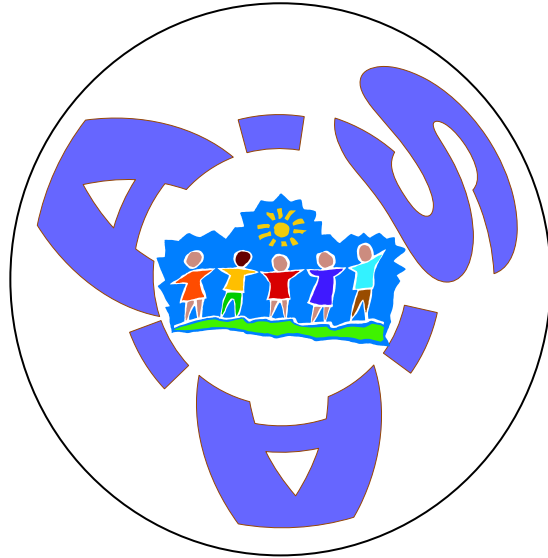


Undergraduate After School Academy Winter 2011

Monday

2's, 3's and 4's (2:00 to 2:45)

Gymnastics— By Cheertastics (www.cheertasticsstars.com): Designed for the beginner students from the 2's through the 4's. This class is taught by trained instructors with 20 years experience and is designed to improve student's flexibility, strength and coordination while teaching and developing gymnastic skills.

Classes include: warm-up, stretch, floor exercises, gymnastic skills, balance work, obstacles and drills. Gym Attire Required (no jeans or jewelry)

3's and 4's (1:00 to 1:45)

Mighty Mathematicians– with Mrs. Larmie: In this class the children learn all about math through manipulatives and play. They will learn all about numbers, counting, adding and subtracting without realizing what they are doing. Our Mrs. Larmie make learning so much fun.

Tuesday

3's and 4's (1:00 to 1:45)

Edible Art—with Mrs. Larmie: In this class Mrs. Larmie takes the children right into the kitchen. They get hands on learning about food while making it fun. It is amazing how much more these children will try once they start helping prepare it. They work on their fine motor skills and get to eat their wonderful creations at the end.

2's (1:00 to 1:30)

Edible Stories—with Mrs. A: Do you have a child that loves books and loves to help you in the kitchen? If so this is a class for that little one. In this class, Mrs. A will read the children a story and then they will do an edible art project. This class is very similar to Edible Art but designed with the younger children in mind. This class will also be held in one of the class rooms rather than the kitchen for the comfort of the children.

Wednesday

2's and 3's (1:15 to 1:45)

Music Fun—with Mrs. Myers: Does your child love music? Then again what child doesn't love music with Mrs. Myers, since children learn through the art of music and dance. In this class Mrs. Myers will keep the children involved not only with play and listening to music but she also has them build instruments to play. From her big drum to the rain stick they make they all seem to love this class.

4's (2:00 to 2:45)

Piano—with Mrs. Myers: This class is a really good introduction to piano. They will learn the basics of music and the piano. However, if your child took this class the first session there is nothing to be worried about, Mrs. Myers is great about picking up where your child left off. He/she will not be starting over. *There is an additional \$50.00 lab fee for this class.

4's (1:00 to 1:45)

Almost Ready to Write– with Mrs. Larmie: This class is designed for those children that are starting to write. Mrs. Larmie will help them perfect their pre-writing skills through many different ways. She has been known to take them outside and have them use sidewalk chalk and they have also been reporters. This class is filled with learning and fun.

Thursday

2's and 3's (1:00 to 1:30)

Story Art—with Mrs. A: In this class Mrs. A will read the children a story and then do an art project with them. Mrs. A is a wonderful teacher as many of you already know, the art project that she will do with them could be in any of many different types of mediums. She tries to introduce the children to many different and exciting experiences through the world of books and art.

4's (2:00 to 2:45)

Orff– with Mrs. Myers: Orff Schulwerk is a way to teach and learn music. It is based on things children like to do: sing, chant rhymes, clap, dance and keep a beat on anything near at hand. These instincts are directed into learning music by hearing and making music first, then reading and writing it later. This is the same way we all learn language. The Orff instruments include wooden xylophones and metal glockenspiels. Played together as in a small orchestra, they provide beautiful syncopated music!

Friday

4's (3:00 to 4:00)

Karate– with Sensei Dave of Villari's Martial Arts: This is the same class that has been running from the beginning of the year. However, if you wish to have your child join the class now you may still do so. Please contact the office for more information.

4's (1:15 to 2:00)

Fantastic Fridays—with Mrs. Larmie: This was a late add on last session. A few of you asked for it and we had such a good response we decided to keep it. Thanks to those parents for the suggestion.
